The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioners Rakesh Bind and Manoj Bind apprehending their arrest in connection with Mufassil P.S. Case No. 234/2025 registered for the offences punishable under sections 126(2), 115(2), 125(a), 303(2), 74, 109, 308(3) and 3(5) of the BNS.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that both the parties are neighbours and on account of some petty dispute, scuffle ensued between them. He further submits that during the course of free fight, members of both the parties sustained some injuries and the petitioners have also lodged a counter case against the informant party, registered as Mufassil P.S. Case No. 229/2025.

Ld. counsel further submits that subsequently the present case was got instituted being Mufassil P.S. Case No. 234/2025 at the instance of the accused persons of earlier case i.e. Mufassil P.S. Case No. 229/2025. Ld. counsel further submits that no significant injury has been caused to anyone and that, the petitioners carry no criminal antecedents.

Ld. counsel further submits that during the course of time, both the parties have settled their dispute and differences and now good feeling has been restored and a joint compromise application in

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this regard, duly signed by both the parties has already been filed in the Court of Ld. CJM, a certified copy of which has been attached with this anticipatory bail application.

Ld. P.P. has also been heard in opposition to the prayer for bail.

Taking note of the aforesaid submissions, particularly the submission that the petitioners carry no criminal antecedents and the present case is a counter blast of earlier case being Mufassil P.S. Case No. 229/2025, the prayer for anticipatory bail of these petitioners is hereby **allowed**. It is directed that the petitioners in the event of arrest or surrender before the court concerned within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, the petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.30,000/-** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned with condition as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
