The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of petitioner Sudama Singh who is in judicial custody since 10.03.2026 in connection with Gurua P.S. Case No. 57/2025 registered for the offence punishable under sections 8(b) and 20(a)(i) of the NDPS Act.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that he has no concern with the alleged recovery of Ganja and he carries no criminal antecedents. He further submits that this petitioner has surrendered on 10.03.2026 and has remained in judicial custody since then, hence, the prayer for regular bail of this petitioner may be considered favourably.

Ld. Spl. P.P. vehemently opposed the prayer submitting that earlier the prayer for anticipatory bail of this petitioner was rejected vide order dated 12.03.2025 passed in Spl. ABP No. 21/2025 subsequently this petitioner approached the Hon'ble High Court and his prayer for anticipatory bail was also rejected by the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 07.08.2025 in Cri. Misc. No. 28305 of 2025.

Ld. Spl. P.P. further submits that from the residential premises of this petitioner and one more co-accused 25 kilograms of Ganja has been recovered. He further submits that the said quantity falls under the commercial quantity, hence, in

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view of the bar imposed under Section 37 of the NDPS Act, the prayer for bail of this petitioner should not be entertained.

I have considered the submissions as advanced by the parties and have perused the order dated 07.08.2025 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in Cri. Misc. No. 28305 of 2025 wherein the prayer for anticipatory bail of this petitioner and the other accused has been rejected while referring the nature of accusations and recovery of 25 kilograms of Ganja from the petitioner's house.

Taking note of the aforesaid submissions and in view of such serious allegations relating to the commission of an offence involving commercial quantity of NDPS substance, being 25 kilograms of Ganja, this court does not find it to be a fit case for extending the privilege of bail specially in view of the prohibition imposed by the statute under section 37 of the NDPS Act and as such the prayer for bail of this petitioner is hereby **rejected**.
