Ld. Counsel for plaintiff submitted that the PF could not be filed earlier due to reasons stated in the application u/s. 151 CPC filed on 25.03.2026.

Steps be taken within 7 working days.

Service affidavit to be filed with tracking reports.

Plaintiff is directed to file an affidavit affirming the e-mail address and whats app number of the defendant under Rule 12 of the “Delhi Courts Services of Process by courier, fax and electronic mail service (Civil Proceedings) Rules 2010”.

Further, in terms of Rule 13, plaintiff is directed to place on record a copy of the plaint and documents in electronic format / scanned images for forwarding / annexing / attaching the same with the process. Requisite process fee for sending process by e-mail in compliance of Rule 14 be also filed within a week along with the copies as above for onward transmission to Nazarat

Branch, Tis Hazari Courts for service through e-mail.

The written statement has to be filed by the said defendant within 30 days (extendable upto 120 days with the leave of the court and that too subject to appropriate terms) from the date of service of the process as per the Proviso of Sub Rule 1 of Order 5 Rule 1 CPC as applicable to the Commercial Courts Act.

For appearance of defendant and further proceedings, put up on **20.05.2026**.
