ORDER

This bail petition has been pressed today for hearing on behalf of the petitioners namely **1. Soni Devi and 2. Sadanand Singh @ Anand Kumar** who are apprehending their arrest in connection with this Buniyadganj P.S. Case No. 362/2025 registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 132, 352, 3(5) of B.N.S.

Heard learned counsel Sri Rajballabh Singh appearing on behalf of the accused/Petitioner and learned A.P.P. for the State.

Apart from pleading innocence and false implication Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submit that allegation against petitioners are vague and omnibus in nature. Ld. Counsel further submits that co-accused persons who were arrested in this case and produced before Ld. Trial Court and they were released on PR bond and subsequently, they surrendered before the Ld. Trial Court from where they were granted bail on the day of surrender itself.

Ld. Counsel further submits that there is no any specific allegation with respect to causing any injury and no any injury as such found on the person of any of the victims. Ld. Counsel further submits that petitioners have no criminal antecedent and out of two petitioners, one is woman.

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In the light of said submissions Ld. Counsel for the petitioner prays for extending the anticipatory bail.

The Ld. P.P has opposed the prayer of bail.

Heard both the sides. Perused the record.

From perusal of FIR it appears that allegations against petitioners are omnibus in nature. No any witnesses of locality has been associated in the process of investigation. Para 32 of case diary reveals that no any injury report was prepared. One of the petitioners is woman. Petitioners also claimed to have clean hands.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of this case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners. If the accused petitioners appear before the learned trial Court below within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the order to trial court, they shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the original Court with the statutory conditions particularized u/s 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S.

This anticipatory bail application is hereby **allowed**.
