The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of petitioner Jitendra Kumar who is in judicial custody since 11.03.2026 in connection with Mufassil P.S Case No. 56/2026 registered for the offence punishable under sections 303(2), 317(2), 111(3), 111(4) of the BNS and 21 of the Mines & Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act and 56 of the BM (CPIMTS) Rules.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case due to local politics. He further submits that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 11.03.2026.

Ld. counsel further submits that the petitioner is the owner of the tractor bearing Registration No. BR-02-GC-1215 which was allegedly seized from the site in question. He further submits that the petitioner has no concern whatsoever with the alleged illegal mining of sand, as alleged by the informant.

Ld. counsel further submits that the co-accused persons namely Uday Kumar Singh @ Langra, Nitish Kumar have already been granted

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anticipatory bail vide order dated 07.03.2026 passed in ABP No. 673/2026 and another co-accused person namely Suresh Yadav has been granted regular bail vide order dated 04.04.2026 passed in BP No. 552/2026, hence the prayer for regular bail of this petitioner may also be considered favourably.

Ld. P.P. has also been heard in opposition to the prayer for bail.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, particularly the submission that the petitioner has remained in custody since 11.03.2026, the prayer for regular bail of this petitioner is hereby **allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 25,000/-** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Id. court below.
