06-05-2026 :- The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Alipur P.S. Case no. 150/2025, registered for the offence punishable U/S 190, 126(2), 115(2),109 (1), 74, 303 (2) 352, 351 (2) BNS pending in the court of learned A C.J.M.VIth, Gaya Jee.

The prosecution story in narrow compass. The informant has given a fardbyan to the S.H.O. Magadh- Medical P.S. inter alia therein stating that on 09-10-25 at about 5.30 P.M. he along with his family members was at home and in the meantime all accused persons came there lashed with club, stick and axe and started abusing him. Thereafter accused, Awadhesh Paswan, assaulted him by means of iron-rod due to which he sustained injury on his head and when his wife interceded the accused persons also assaulted her and taken away cash Rs. 10,000/- from his house and also snatched a golden chain. And to this effect an F.I.R has been registered.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are quite innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that earlier to this no such an application for anticipatory bail has ever been filed on behalf of the petitioners either before learned Principal District and Sessions Judge, Gaya Jee, or Hon'ble High Court. He further submits there is no criminal antecedent behind the petitioners. He further submits that the allegation of theft appears to be ornamental and concocted. He further submits that the

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petitioner no. 1, Awadhesh Paswan, and prosecution party are co-villagers and a scuffle took place for the drainage water and the informant has dragged all the relatives of the petitioner no. 1 in this case. He further submits that there is omnibus and general allegation against the petitioner. He further submits that photo-copy of injury report is attached with the F.I.R. according to which no significant injury has been sustained by the informant. He further submits that there is inordinate delay of more than fortnight in lodging the F.I.R. and there is no explanation in this regard. He further submits that the petitioners are ready to face trial and prays for anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner vehemently.

Under the facts and circumstances stated above and having regard to the rival submissions of both sides and after perusal of the F.I.R., and injury report, this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Let the petitioners be released on bail in the event of their arrest or surrender in the court below within a period of three weeks from the date of communication of this order on furnishing bail bond of rupees 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the court below subject to conditions laid down u/s 482(2) BNSS.

Accordingly, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed**.
