The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of petitioner Anil Rawani @ Tiger who is in judicial custody since 14.02.2026 in connection with Kotwali P.S. Case No. 94/2026 registered for the offence punishable under sections 25(1-A), 25(1-B)(a), 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case.

Ld. counsel further submits that the informant has alleged that on 13.02.2026, the SHO of Kotwali P.S., Dhananjay Kumar Singh received information that certain persons were negotiating for the sale of illegal arms and ammunition at Golbagicha Gadba and acting upon the said information, the informant along with the police team reached the place of occurrence and on seeing the police two persons attempted to flee but were apprehended on the spot. Subsequently, during the search of the house of the petitioner, 96 cartridges were allegedly recovered.

Ld. counsel further submits that the allegations are baseless and concocted with the intention to falsely implicate this petitioner and in fact, he has nothing to do with the alleged offence. He further submits the alleged 96 cartridges have been recovered from the

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house of this petitioner and nothing has been recovered from the physical possession of this petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner is languishing in jail since 14.02.2026, hence the prayer for bail of this petitioner may be considered favourably.

Ld. P.P. has also been heard in opposition to the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions, particularly the submission that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 14.02.2026, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is hereby **allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 25,000/-** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned.
