This is an application for grant of regular bail filed on behalf of the accused- petitioner namely Saurabh Kumar @ Rawani who is in custody since 22.03.2026 in connection with Kotwali P.S.case No. 38 of 2026 registered under sections 96, of BNS. Chargesheet is submitted against the petitioner u/s 137(2), 64 of BNS, sections 4 and 8 of POCSO Act. 2. Father of the victim is the informant of this case. According to the First Information Report, case of the prosecution is that, Victim namely Miss “A” (original name withheld) aged about 16 years, on 19.01.2026 at about 10:00 A.M., informant's daughter left her house for attending her school, but did not return home. During search and inquiry, suspicion arose against the petitioner(herein), who runs a fast food stall at Bairagi Mod and resides in a rented house near Ramruchi school. It has been alleged that the accused had enticed and taken away the minor girl. Informant further stated that, he visited the residence of accused and tried to contact him through mobile numbers but neither the accused nor the victim could be traced. Thereafter, the present case was lodged against the petitioner. 3. It has been submitted by Ld. counsel on behalf of the petitioner, that petitioner is quite innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Vide para 2 of bail application, it is submitted that, earlier petitioner has not moved any anticipatory or regular bail application before this Ld. Court or before Hon’ble High Court Patna. Vide para 3 of bail application, it is submitted that, petitioner does not have any criminal

antecedents. The petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR and he has been implicated on mere suspicion. On the aforesaid ground, prayer has been made to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

4. On the other hand, learned Special Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail and submitted that victim is a minor girl and there is serious and direct allegations against the petitioner. Therefore, the petitioner is not entitled to be enlarged on bail.

5. Heard both the parties and perused the case record and after perusal of the case record, it transpires that this case has been registered under sections 96 of BNS. . As per School certificate of victim, date of birth of victim is 03.04.2011 that is around 15 years, which is less than 18 years, at the time of occurrence i.e 19.01.2026. Perusal of case diary shows that witnesses have supported the prosecution case. As per victim's statement recorded u/s 183 of BNSS, victim has stated that petitioner(herein) has kidnapped her and also raped her. I.O. of this case found this case true and submitted chargesheet u/s 137(2), 64 of BNS, sections 4 and 8 of POCSO Act against the petitioner. Allegations are direct and serious in nature against the petitioner.

6. Thus, considering the above discussed facts and circumstances, this court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner Saurabh Kumar @ Rawani on bail. Hence, this bail petition is hereby rejected.
