The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Kosmi Devi who is in judicial custody since 23.02.2026 in connection with Paraiya P. S. Case No.50/2026 registered for the offences punishable U/ss 126(2), 115(2), 109, 103, 3(5) of the BNS.

Prosecution case, in brief, as per Fardebyan of the informant Pramukh Kumar is that on 10.01.2026 at about 09:00 A.M., due to land dispute, the accused/petitioner along with co-accused persons armed with lathi-danda, iron-rod brutally assaulted informant's mother with intention to kill her which resulted in serious injury. On alarm, the villagers came and brought the injured Reshmi Devi to private hospital where from she was brought to ANMMCH, Gaya and thereafter she was referred to PMCH, Patna for better treatment. It is further alleged that during the course of treatment the injured Reshmi Devi died on 28.01.2026.

Apart from submission of false implication of this petitioner, the Id. Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that land dispute is going between the parties and petitioner has been roped in the concocted case only to grab the land of the petitioner. It is further submitted that both the parties are family members and petitioner and deceased are own sisters. He further submits that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 23.02.2026 and after investigation, chargesheet has been submitted against this petitioner.

Ld. P. P. has also been heard in opposition.

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I have perused the case record as well as the materials available on the trial court record. The petitioner is named accused and as per FIR, the allegation against her is that due to land dispute, she along with co-accused persons brutally assaulted Reshmi Devi who died during the course of treatment. After perusal of case diary, attached with trial court record, it appears that the informant's mother and petitioner are own sisters and own Gotni. It further appears from perusal of trial court record that the death of Reshmi Devi caused due to intracranial hemorrhage. Furthermore, there is no specific overt act causing fatal injury has been attributed to the petitioner and she happens to be a female who is in judicial custody since 23.02.2026 and chargesheet has been submitted against this petitioner.

Considering the aforesaid, the prayer for bail of this petitioner is hereby allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- with two sureties of the like each to the satisfaction of the Id. court concerned.
