The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Sahanawaz Ahmad who is in judicial custody since 21.01.2026 in connection with Civil Lines P.S Case No.20/2025 registered for the offences punishable under sections 316(2), 318(4), 3(5) BNS.

Prosecution case, in brief, as per written report of the informant Dr. Sahazad Ahmad is that on 31.08.2024 at about 4:00 P.M., Sahanawaz Ahmad, Marketing Head of Nova Marketing Solutions Patna, visited at his house and told him about business and said that if he deposits Rs.10,00,000/- he will become Sriram Urolax Super Stokis and in addition to that if he deposits Rs.5,00,000/- he will become Super Stokist of Nova Lubricant. It is further alleged that he was called at Hotel Saraogi where he met Arshad Hussain Area Sales Manager, Ahmad Hussain Sales Representative and Md. Rahim Ansari who were there for the purpose of distributorship. It is further alleged that during the period 02.09.2026 to 29.09.2024, he paid Rs.13,50,000/- and got e-mail from hr@nmsolution.in and novalubricants2016@gmail.com of two agreement on his e-mail being shahzadahmed31@gmail.com and remaining amount Rs.55,000/- has been paid by him on 07.10.2024 and Rs.95,000/- has been paid on 15.10.2024. It is further alleged that Sri Durga Nand is head of the Nova Marketing and in his account bearing

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No.5786201100001197 Bank of India, Patliputra Branch Rs.7,95,000/- was deposited and Rs.7,05,000/- cash was given to the Shahanawaz Ahmad and after taking money both of them assured the informant about delivery of goods within two days. It is further alleged that after payment of total amount the accused persons did not deliver goods. It is further alleged that the informant has apprehension that he has been cheated by Durga Nand Mishra and Sahanawaz Ahmad.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the present case has been instituted by way of an FIR, in respect of monetary transaction of Rs.15,00,000/- by the informant between the petitioner and one Durga Nand Mishra. He further submits that petitioner has neither taken any amount from the informant nor there is any document available on the record to show the involvement of this petitioner in the alleged offence.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that the transaction has been done in the account of Durga Nand Mishra who is head of Nova Marketing. He further submits that petitioner is lying in judicial custody since 21.01.2026.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner by filing a petition submits that petitioner is also accused in Phulwarisarif P.S Case No.618/2021 and Complaint Case No.1396/2026 at Patna Sadar.

Ld. P.P as well as ld. Counsel for the informant has also been heard in opposition.

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Considering the aforesaid submissions, particularly the submission that petitioner is lying in judicial custody since 21.01.2026, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned on the following conditions that:

- (i) One of the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
