This anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of above named accused/petitioners, who are apprehending their arrest, in connection with ***Muffassil P.S. Case No. 234/2025***, for the offences registered **U/s. 126(2), 115(2), 125(a), 303(2), 109, 74, 308(3), 3(5) of the B.N.S., pending in the Court of Ld. C.J.M., Gaya.**

2. Heard both the sides on the bail application.

3. Learned defence counsel submitted that prior to this, the petitioners have not filed any anticipatory bail petition before this Court or the Hon'ble Patna High Court. It is further submitted that petitioners are innocent, committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. This case is the counter case of Muffassil P.S. Case No. 229/2025. Both parties have entered into the compromise in both cases and do not want to proceed with the case and certified copy of compromise petition is also filed. Anticipatory bail of other co-accused persons have already been granted by Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judge, Gaya vide A.B.P. No. 1039/2026, dated 19.03.2026 and the case of the petitioners stand on similar footing. Lastly he submitted that petitioners having no criminal antecedent. Hence, it is prayed for grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners.

4. Per contra the Ld. A.P.P. appeared on behalf of State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

5. Prosecution case, in brief, as per informant is that on 10.03.2025 she went to pluck the Munga from the Tree, in the meantime accused petitioner and other co-accused persons armed with weapons came and started pelting bricks and stones upon the informant and claimed that the said Munga tree is theirs. Thereafter all accused persons assaulted informant and her family members and caused them injuries.

6. Heard both the parties and perused the material available on record. From perusal, it appears that petitioners are named in the F.I.R. The allegation against the petitioners is that they along with other co-accused persons assaulted informant and her family members and caused them injuries. There is case and counter case between the parties. Both parties have compromised this case outside the Court and certified copy of compromise petition has also filed. Today informant of this case present in the Court and admitted the factom of compromise and she also endorsed her thumb impression on the order sheet. Moreover other co-accused persons have already been granted anticipatory bail by Ld. P.D.S.J.-Gaya, Gaya vide A.B.P. No. 1039/2026, dated 19.03.2026.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and other materials on record, this court thinks it fit to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, it is directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within a month from the date of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each subject to the all conditions stipulated u/s. 482 of BNSS.
