The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Anil Singh apprehending his arrest in connection with Complaint Case No.225/2025 registered for the offences punishable under sections 316(2) of the BNS.

Complainant's case, in brief, is that in the year 2024, the marriage of his daughter was fixed with Kush Kumar and an amount of Rs.15,51,000/- was given by way of gift. It is further alleged that before solemnization of marriage, the complainant got information that Lav Kush Kumar has criminal history and after proper inquiry, the complainant denied to marry his daughter. It is further alleged that the accused persons did not return the amount which were given at the time of fixing marriage.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that Kush Kumar is meritorious student and from the prosecution case, it is clear that the complainant has denied to marry his daughter. He further submits that the claim made about paying of Rs.15,51,000/- is totally false and baseless rather the complainant has paid Rs.6,00,000/- and the same has been returned to the complainant in presence Panch namely Vijay Singh and one Vikash Sing, the villager as well as Mohan Singh, the nephew of complainant and one Yogendra Singh and own GOTIAS. of his family and GOTIAS. He further submits that the prosecution side assaulted Lav Kumar and demanded

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Rs.5,00,000/- by way of ransom and for the same Complaint Case No.126(c)/2025 has been brought by Lav Kumar which is still pending.

I have considered the aforesaid submissions and have perused the case record. The present complaint case has been brought in the year 2025 alleging that some amount was given at the time of fixing marriage to the accused/petitioner. Further, the complaint case was brought against the accused persons namely Anil Singh, Lav Kumar, Kush Kumar @ Chhotu, Janardan Prasad, Sushila Devi and Pawan Kumar and on 19.02.2026, cognizance has been taken only against accused/petitioner for the alleged offence under Section 316(2) of the BNS which is punishable with less than seven years.

Taking note of the aforesaid submissions, the prayer for anticipatory bail of this petitioner is hereby allowed. The petitioner is directed to appear before the court concerned within a period of four weeks from today whereupon he shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned with condition as laid down under Section 482 of the BNSS.
