The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of petitioner Arvind Kumar @ Arvind Bharti who is in judicial custody since 08.04.2026 in connection with Bhadwar P. S. Case No. 08/2023 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 8(b), 18 and 29 of the NDPS Act.

Prosecution case, in brief, as per written report of the informant Dinesh Prasad Gupta, Range Officer, Bhadwar Forest Range, is that on 15.02.2023, he along with other Forest officials, police force as well as the team of Narcotics Control Bureau visited village-Navigarh protected forest and found illegal cultivation of opium (Afim) over the forest land measuring area 14.03 acres and 02 Acres in non-forest land. The opium plants were destroyed and informant came to know that the accused persons including the petitioner were engaged in the said cultivation of opium.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case merely on the basis of suspicion. He further submits that the petitioner has no concern with the land where opium plants were cultivated. He further submits that the petitioner carries no criminal antecedents.

Ld. Counsel further submits that similarly situated co-accused namely Sanju Yadav and Ashok Singh Bhokta have been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 13.12.2023 passed by the Hon'ble High

Court in Cri. Misc. No. 38533/2023, hence, the prayer for regular bail of this petitioner be also considered favourably.

Ld. Spl. P.P. has been heard in opposition to the prayer for bail.

Taking note of the aforesaid, this court does not find any ground or any reason for not entertaining the prayer for bail of this petitioner in view of the order passed by the Hon'ble High Court in Cri. Misc. No. 38533/2023, dated 13.12.2023 and as such, the prayer for bail of this petitioner is hereby **allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail of Rs.25,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned with additional condition that:

1. One of the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
