The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioners 1. Khushbu Kumari, 2. Neeta Devi and 3. Devanti Devi @ Manorama Devi apprehending their arrest in connection with Mufassil P.S Case No.162/2026 registered for the offences punishable under sections 126(2), 115(2), 329(3), 329(4), 74, 109, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of the BNS.

Prosecution case, in brief, as per written report of the informant Girani Prasad is that on 15.02.2026 at about 10:00 P.M., the informant and his family members were sleeping at home. In the meantime, the accused persons entered the house and started abusing and when the informant raised the objection, the accused persons armed with iron rod attacked on his head which resulted in head injury and he became unconscious and fell down on the ground. It is further alleged that accused Surendra Beldar pulled Saree of informant's wife. Further, the accused Devanti Devi and her daughter-in-law took away Rs.40,000/- from Almirah and threatened to kill. It is further alleged that the injured were brought to PHC Manpur for medical treatment.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that as a matter of fact, the dispute arose over disposal of

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garbage near the house of petitioners due to which some scuffle took place in which both the parties got some insignificant injury and both the parties are members of broader family. He further submits that for the same incident two cases were got registered and the present case is counter blast of Mufassil P.S Case No.161/2026. He further submits that the petitioners are female members and there is no specific allegation against the petitioners. He further submits that petitioners carry no criminal antecedent.

Ld. P.P has also been heard in opposition.

I have considered the submissions as advanced by the parties and have perused the case record as well as case diary. The petitioners are named in the FIR with allegation that they took away some money form the Almirah. After perusal of case record, it appears that there is no specific allegation of overt act against any of the petitioners rather the allegations appear to be general and omnibus in nature. After further perusal of case record, it appears that the petitioners and informant are members of broader family. Upon perusal of case diary, more specifically as per para-85 of the case diary, the injury caused by hard and blunt substance and nature of injury has been found to be simple. As per para-87 of the case diary, the petitioners carry no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, the prayer for anticipatory bail of these petitioners is hereby allowed. It is directed that in the event of arrest or surrender before the court concerned within a period of four

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weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs.25,000/-** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned with additional condition as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
