The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of petitioner Sandeep Kumar Agarwal who is in judicial custody since 15.03.2026 in connection with Mufassil P.S. Case No. 238/2026 registered for the offence punishable under section 310(2) of the BNS.

The prosecution story as per the *fardbayan* of the informant is that he was driving a Tata 909 Cargo vehicle belonging to his brother, Sanjay Kumar. On 01.03.2026, he had loaded consignments of Rajnigandha and Tulsi valued at approximately Rs.64,00,000/- from Ariket BPS Enterprises Pvt. Ltd., Zakariapur, Patna for delivery within the jurisdiction of Wazirganj Police Station. It is alleged that during the course of transportation, after halting for the night he resumed his journey in the earlier morning of 02.03.2026. At about 5:00a.m., upon reaching near the Paimar River Bridge on the Gaya Nawada bypass, a white-coloured car intercepted his vehicle and about 4-5 unknown persons forcibly stopped him, assaulted him and threw him out of the vehicle. Thereafter, two of the accused persons absconded with the loaded vehicle while the remaining accused persons abducted the

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informant, blindfolded him and wrongfully confined him at Tulsi High School, Singh Ghatiya where he was tied up. It is further alleged that the accused persons removed the SIM card from his mobile phone before fleeing, then somehow the informant managed to escape and subsequently informed his brother and the police.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the allegations against the petitioner is false and the petitioner has got no concern with the alleged offence.

Ld. counsel further submits that the FIR was lodged against unknown and this petitioner has falsely been dragged into this case. He further submits that from the house of this petitioner only one mobile phone and an empty cartoon has been recovered and nothing has been recovered from the physical possession of this petitioner. He further submits that one more seizure list has been prepared from the premises of Medni Nagar P.S., and some items have been shown to be recovered to which he has no concern.

Ld. counsel further contended that the petitioner has no involvement and he has not been named in the FIR. He further submits that the petitioner carries no criminal antecedents and is languishing in judicial custody since 15.03.2026, hence the prayer for bail of this petitioner may be considered favourably.

Ld. P.P. has also been heard in opposition.

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I have considered the submissions as advanced by both the parties and have perused the case record along with the case diary. Upon perusal of the same, it appears that the petitioner is not named in the FIR.

Further, from perusal of the seizure list, it appears that one empty cartoon and one mobile phone has been shown to be recovered from the house of this petitioner.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as the submissions, particularly the submission that the petitioner carries no criminal antecedents and is not named in the FIR and that, the petitioner is in judicial custody since 15.03.2026, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is hereby **allowed**. The petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 25,000/-** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned.
