An anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of the above named accused/petitioners, who are apprehending their arrest, in connection with *Tekari P.S. Case No. 17/2026*, for the offences registered **U/s. 191(1), 191(2), 191(3), 126(2), 127(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 109(1), 74, 103(1), 351(2), 351(3) of the BNS**, pending in the Court of Ld. ACJM-VI, Gaya Ji.

2. Heard both the sides on the bail application.

3. Learned defence counsel, submitted that prior to this, the petitioners have not filed any anticipatory bail either before this Court or the Hon'ble Patna High Court. It is further submitted that petitioners are innocent, committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation against the accused petitioners. This case is the counter case of Tekari P.S. Case No. 18/2026. Lastly he submitted that petitioners having no criminal antecedent. Hence, it is prayed for grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners.

4. Per contra the Ld. A.P.P. appeared on behalf of State vehemently opposed the prayer for bail.

5. Prosecution case, in brief, as per fardbeyan of informant is that on 15.01.2026 at about 12.00 P.M. out of his house his wife Nisha Kumari got hit by bicycle of Pankaj Paswan's daughter. On protest, petitioners along with 21 co-accused persons attacked upon with rod and bamboo stick on Malti Devi, Madhesh Paswan, Tuntun Kumar, Suraj Paswan

(informant), Dharmendra Kumar, Kunti Devi and Nisha Devi, due to which all sustained injuries. During the course of treatment, his father Madhesh Paswan died. Hence, this case was instituted.

6. Heard both the parties and perused the case record. From perusal, it appears that petitioners are named in the F.I.R. Allegation against the petitioners are that they along with other co-accused persons assaulted informant and other family members and caused them injuries and during the course of treatment, one injured namely Madhesh Paswan succumbed to death. Statement of witnesses at para 03, 13, 34, 35, 36 & 37 of the case diary in which they have fully supported the case of the prosecution. Vide para 43 of the case diary, the cause of death is due to ***“haemorrhage & shocked due to brain & skull injuries.”*** Allegation against the accused petitioners is serious and grave in nature. Investigation against the accused petitioners is still going on. Moreover similarly situated regular bail of several co-accused persons have already been rejected by this Court.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, gravity of offence and with regard to pending stage of the investigation, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the prayer of anticipatory bail filed and moved on behalf of the petitioners, above named, is hereby **rejected**.
