The present regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner Sachin Kumar who is in judicial custody since 21.03.2026 in connection with Fatehpur P.S Case No.157/2026 registered for the offences punishable U/ss 87, 3(5) of the BNS.

Prosecution case, in brief, as per typed report of the informant Kaili Devi is that on 17.03.2026 at about 6:00 P.M., she had gone to work in the field, her minor daughter aged about 16 years, was alone at her home. During that time, the accuse person namely Sachin Kumar and Ashutosh Kumar in furtherance of common intention, allegedly lured the victim and forcibly took her away in a four-wheeler to an unknown place. It is further alleged that some villagers had seen the accused persons taking the victim along with them. Upon returning, the informant found her daughter missing, during search she came to know about the occurrence. The informant also expressed apprehension that the accused persons may cause harm to her minor daughter.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that he has no concern with the alleged offence. He further submits that petitioner has no love and affair with the informant's daughter rather the informant's daughter used to talk with one Pritam Kumar. He further submits that informant's daughter met the petitioner on Patna Railway Station and the police arrested the petitioner while they were talking on the Patna Railway Station. He further submits that informant's daughter is not a minor girl. He further submits that petitioner having no criminal antecedent is lying in judicial custody since 21.03.2026.

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Ld. P.P has also been heard in opposition.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and period of custody, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned with additional conditions that :

(i) One of the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
