An anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of the above named accused/petitioners, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with **Vishnupad P.S. Case No. 187/2026**, for the offences registered **U/s. 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 303(2), 3(5) of the IPC, pending in the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-VI, Gaya.**

Heard both the sides on the bail application.

Learned defence counsel, submitted that prior to this, the petitioners have not filed any anticipatory bail before this Court or before the Hon'ble Patna High Court. It is further submitted that petitioners are innocent, committed no offence and have been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that the instant case is counter blast of Vishnupad P.S. Case No. 188/2026 which has been lodged by one of accused petitioner Kashish Kumari. All Sections are bailable except Section 303(2) of BNS which has been added only for making the case non-bailable. Lastly he submitted that petitioner no. 1 & 3 having no criminal antecedent while petitioner no. 2 has one criminal antecedent vide Civil Lines P.S. Case No. 192/2007. Hence, it is prayed to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners.

Per contra the Ld. A.P.P. appeared on behalf of State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Prosecution case, in brief, as per informant is that on 10.04.2026 at about 10.30 A.M. all the petitioners came into informant's house and abused, assaulted and snatched gold ear ring from her, due to which he received ear injury. When her daughter came to

save her, then they also assaulted her resultantly she received scar marks on her face from their nails. Accused Sudhir Kumar issued threat to kill her husband and son and kidnapped her daughter.

Heard both the parties and perused the material available on record. From perusal, it appears that petitioners are named in the F.I.R. The allegation against the accused petitioners are of abusing, assaulting with the informant and her daughter and also of snatching ear ring from informant's daughter. There is no specific allegation against the accused petitioners. There is case and counter between the parties. There is scuffle took place between both the parties for puppy (dog's child).

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and other materials on record, this court thinks it fit to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, it is directed that in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Ld. Court below within a month from the date of this order, the petitioners shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each along with all the conditions stipulated u/s. 438 (2) of Cr.P.C.
