ORDER

26.05.2026

A regular bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner who was moved today, who is in custody since 05.12.2025 in connection with Khizersarai P.S. Case No. 08/2025, registered u/ss 305 of B.N.S., which is pending in the Court of Smt. Sneha, Ld. JMFC, Gaya.

Prosecution case in short is that on 16.01.2025, informant was sleeping in a room located inside the Patnari wholesale market, near Bana More. Upon waking up at 5:00 a.m he found that the lock on the market's main gate had been broken and the chain gate was open, the entire market's cash collection- amounting approximately Rs. 8,00000/- was missing. CCTV cameras installed in the shop had been damaged and the culprits had fled with the DVR and hard disk.

The Ld. Counsel for the petitioners submitted that earlier no bail petition either regular or anticipatory has been filed on behalf the petitioner either before this Court or any Higher Court. It is further submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Petitioner has not caught on spot and nothing has been recovered from conscious possession. I.O has submitted charge-sheet against the petitioner and there is no mention of the criminal history in the entire case diary. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in judicial custody since 05.12.2025. It has been further submitted that the entire allegation against the petitioner is false and baseless and prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The Ld. A.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail of the petitioners.

Heard the Ld. counsel for the petitioner as well as Ld. A.P. for the State and perused the record. On perusal of record, it transpires that this case has been registered u/ss 305 of B.N.S. against unknown persons. On the basis of confession statement of petitioner recorded before the police in Tekari P.S case No. 141/2025 which is mentioned in para 27 of case diary, petitioner has been remanded in this case. Allegation against the petitioner is that he along with his other associates has

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committed the crime of theft. As per para 3 of bail petition, petitioner has 10 criminal antecedents and as per submission all cases were registered against unknown. There is no recovery from the petitioner. Charge-sheet has been submitted against the petitioner in this case. Petitioner is in judicial custody since 05.12.2025.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and also having regard to the submissions of the parties and material available on the record, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of **Rs. 20,000/- (Twenty Thousand)** with two sureties of the like amount, each to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below with further condition that:

- (I) Bail bond of petitioner shall be accepted after framing of charge.
- (II) One of bailor shall be blood relative of the petitioner supported with an official document.
- (III) Petitioner shall physically present on each and every date and on absence of two consecutive dates bail bond of the petitioner shall be automatically cancelled.
- (IV) Petitioner shall not involve in such kind of offences in future.
