The present anticipatory bail petition has been filed and pressed today for order on behalf of above named petitioners who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Fatehpur P.S. Case No.489 of 2025 for committing offence u/s 74, 75, 352, 3(5) of BNS, pending in the Court of Learned C.J.M., Gaya Ji.

Heard Learned Advocate for the petitioners and Learned A.P.P. for the State.

This present case has been instituted by the fardbayan given by the informant namely Satnarayan Pandey and he alleged that on 02.07.2025 at about 08:00 P.M., his all four daughters were coming from the field after attending the nature's call. On the way above petitioners along with other co-accused surrounded his daughters and co-accused Biru Kumar snatched the dupatta of one his daughter Khushboo Kumari and started abusing them. After that the girls tried to run away from there, the accused persons misbehaved with them. Then they began to shout for the help, then people from the nearby came for their rescue. On seeing the people they ran away. He further stated that the accused persons are habitually offenders. Hence this case.

The Learned defence counsel humbly submitted that the petitioners have not filed any bail either anticipatory or regular bail petition before this Court or any Hon'ble higher Court. Further he submitted that petitioners are quite innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case merely with a view to harass the petitioners. Lastly, he submitted that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent, so the petitioners may be given the privilege of anticipatory bail.

The Learned A.P.P. opposed the prayer and prayed to dismiss the petition of bail filed by the petitioners.

Heard the Learned Counsels for both the sides and perused the case record. From perusal of case record, it transpires that this case has been registered for the offence u/s 74, 75, 352, 3(5) of BNS against the co-accused along with present petitioners. Ld. APP for State is afforded many opportunities to produce updated case diary but after several reminder also Investigating Officer of this case has not produced updated case diary.

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From perusal of record and FIR, it transpires that there is no specific allegation against above named petitioners. Allegation against the present petitioners are general and omnibus in nature. From perusal of Para No.3 of case diary, it transpires that present petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case as discussed above the nature of allegation against the petitioners, I find it proper to enlarge the petitioners on bail. Let the above named petitioners are directed to be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below, within a period of 01 month from the date of receipt of this order on furnishing of bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount with conditions as laid down u/s 482(2) of BNSS. Subject to the condition is that the petitioners are directed to duly and regularly appear before the concerned Court on the dates of hearing fixed. It is, however, made clear that any observation made herein shall not be treated as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
