The present petition for regular bail has been filed on behalf of petitioners 1. Rajaram Yadav 2. Deepak Kumar 3. Suresh yadav who are in judicial custody since 20.04.2026 in connection with Belaganj P.S. Case No. 241/2026 registered for the offence punishable under sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109(1), 303(2), 324(4) and 351(2) of the BNS.

The prosecution story as per the informant in brief is that on 19.04.2026, during the course of alnd measurement, a quarrel ensued between the women of both the sides. Consequent to this altercation, the accused petitioners along with others began abusing and assaulting him with Lathi and Danda. In the course of the incident, the informant was assaulted by the accused petitioner no. 2 causing a head injury. When one Rinku Kumari attempted to intervene and bring about reconciliation, she too was assaulted, sustaining serious injuries. It is further alleged that during the occurrence, the mobile phone and a sum of Rs.2,000/- were snatched away from the possession of the informant.

Ld. counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the

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petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case and, in fact, they have committed no offence as alleged in the FIR.

Ld. counsel further contended that in the background of some land dispute, dispute arose between the two groups resulting in scuffle and institution of this case. He further submits that during the course of scuffle, both the parties sustained some injuries but there was absolutely no intention to cause death or to cause any significant injury to anyone.

Ld. counsel further submits that during the course of time, both the parties have settled their dispute and differences and now good feeling has been restored. He further submits that a joint compromise application duly signed by both the parties has already been filed in the Court of Ld. CJM, Gaya, certified copy of which has been attached with this bail application.

Ld. counsel further contended that the petitioners carry no criminal antecedents and are languishing in judicial custody since 20.04.2026. He further submits that in the background of the same incident two cases were got registered one being Belaganj P.S. Case No. 242/2026 at the instance of the petitioners' party and the other being the present one.

Ld. P.P. has also been heard in opposition.

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Considering the aforesaid submissions, particularly the submission that the petitioners carry no criminal antecedents and are in judicial custody since 20.04.2026 and also in view of the joint compromise application, the prayer for bail of the petitioners is hereby **allowed**. The petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of **Rs. 25,000/-** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned.
