The present petition for anticipatory bail has been filed on behalf of petitioners 1. Manjit Singh, 2. Harsh Kumar, 3. Sima Devi, 4. Monu Kumar, 5. Amit Kumar @ Alex apprehending their arrest in connection with Magadh Medical P.S Case No.27/2026 registered for the offences punishable under sections 191(2), 191(3), 115(2), 110 of the BNS and 27 Arms Act.

Prosecution case, in brief, as per written report of the informant Ravi Kumar is that on 25.01.2026 at about 4:00 Hrs., he along with his brother were going to Sujata Library and as soon his brother reached Magadh Colony Road No.17 near the house of Manjit Singh, the wife of Manjit Singh caught his brother and started assaulted him. It is further alleged that the wife of Manjit Singh along with her family members and some unknown persons brutally assaulted him. It is further alleged that accused Amit Kumar @ Alex fired gunshot and attacked with butt of Pistol due to which he became unconscious and fell on the ground.

Ld. Counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that some minor scuffle took place between the parties and no one has sustained any significant injury. He further submits that petitioners carry no criminal antecedent and the matter has been amicably settled and compromised between both the parties.

Ld. P.P has also been heard in opposition.

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I have considered the submissions as advanced by the parties and have perused the case record as well as case diary. The petitioners are named in the FIR with the said allegation that they have assaulted the informant's brother due to which he got injured. After perusal of case diary, it appears that there is no reference of any firing of gunshot in the case diary and also there is no reference of any medical treatment in the case diary. Moreover, the matter has been amicably settled and compromised between both the parties and a certified copy of compromise petition has been attached with this anticipatory bail application.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is hereby allowed. It is directed that the petitioners in the event of arrest or surrender before the court concerned within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, they are ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the court concerned with condition as laid down u/s 482 of the BNSS.
