An anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of above named accused/petitioners, who are apprehending their arrest, in connection with **Fatehpur P.S. Case No. 134/2026**, for the offences registered **U/s. 191(2), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 132, 324(4)(5) of the B.N.S., pending in the Court of Ld. C.J.M., Gaya.**

2. Heard both the sides on the bail application.
3. Learned defence counsel, submitted that prior to this, the petitioners have not filed either anticipatory or regular bail petition before this Court or the Hon'ble Patna High Court. It is further submitted that petitioners are innocent, committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case. It is further submitted that the real fact is that informant and other person broken the statue of Ambedkar and chabutra for which they objected for the same and some hot talk took place between them and the present case has been lodged against the petitioners. Lastly, he submitted that the petitioners having no criminal antecedent. Hence, it is prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners.
4. Per contra the Ld. A.P.P. appeared on behalf of State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.
5. Prosecution case, in brief, as per informant Pramod Kumar Saw, Block Panchayati Raj Officer, is that a land was selected for constructing the Panchayat Sarkar Bhawan in Gram Panchayat Nagwan in Thana No. 545, Khata No. 533, Khesra No. 1306, Rakwa 50 Decimal. On

15.04.2025 land demarcation report was given for work on the land vide Letter No. 456/SA. On 31.12.2025 he with the help of police personnel reached at the said land for beginning the work but people of village started obstructing them from starting the work over the said land and when informant and others tried to convince them then they started pelting stones over the government employees, due to which one police man sustained injury. Again instruction was given to start the work but the anti-social elements present there forcibly stopped the work and damaged the construction equipments. They were identified as accused petitioners and co-accused persons and other 15-20 unknown.

6. Heard both sides and perused the case record. From perusal of the case record, it appears that petitioners are named in the F.I.R. There is allegation against the petitioners of obstructing the government employees from discharging their duties and also of damaging the construction equipments. Statement of witnesses and injured at para 03, 08, 09, 10 & 22 of the case diary in which they have fully supported the case of the prosecution. Vide para 40 of the case diary, for serving the notice U/S 35(3) of BNSS all accused persons were searched but no one appeared to receive the notice. Allegation against the accused petitioners are serious in nature. Investigation against the accused petitioner is still going on.

7. Thus, considering the facts and circumstances of the case as discussed above, nature of offence and with regard to pending stage of the investigation, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail. Hence, the prayer for anticipatory bail to the petitioners is hereby rejected.
