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20.07.2026 File taken up today on the Criminal Miscellaneous application filed by the Ld. Counsel of the applicant **Sonu Vikash S/o Satendra Sharma**, for extension of the time for surrender as given in the order dated 21.11.2024, while granting the anticipatory bail to the applicant. Copy of the same has already supplied to the Ld. A.P.P.

It is submitted by the Ld Counsel of the applicant that the he could not surrender and furnish his bail bond within stipulated time as petitioner fell seriously ill and remained under Medical treatment and due to his medical condition, he was advised complete bed rest by the doctor and was physically incapable of travelling and appearing before this Court for furnishing bail bond within stipulated period. Therefore prayed that extension of time be given to surrender and furnish the bail bond before Ld. Trial court.

Ld. A.P.P. for the State considering the circumstances has not opposed the same, however submitted that the same may be allowed subjected to cost.

Heard and perused the material available on record. From perusal, it transpires that on 21.11.2024, A.B.P. No. 1666/2024 of the applicant namely **Sonu Vikash** was allowed and it was directed ***“in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court concerned within a period of one month from the date of order on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousands) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court Concerned in connection with “ Kotwali P.S. Case No. 96/2017”,*** however the applicant could not surrender and furnish his bail bond within time as per directions and today filed an application.

Considering the facts and circumstances, this present Criminal miscellaneous application is allowed with the direction to deposit Rs. 1,000/- in the Nazarat, Civil Court, Gaya and he is given further 15 days more from today to surrender and furnish his bail bonds before the Court concerned, rest of the conditions would be remained as it is.

Accordingly, the present Criminal Miscellaneous application is disposed of with above observations.

Copy of this order be sent to the concerned Court to proceed in accordance with law.
