This bail application has been filed on behalf of above named accused/petitioner, who is in judicial custody since 05.05.2026, in connection with **Civil Lines P.S. Case No. 171/2026**, for the offences registered **U/s. 303(2) of the B.N.S., pending in the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.-I, Gaya.**

2. Heard both the sides on the bail application.

3. Learned defence counsel submitted that prior to this, the petitioner has not filed anticipatory or regular bail before this Court or the Hon'ble Patna High Court. It is further submitted that petitioner is innocent, committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. The theft motorcycle bearing registration No. BR02BK-0537 has not been recovered from the possession of the petitioner but on confession of co-accused Monu Kumar, the petitioner has been arrested and remanded in Buniyadganj P.S. Case No. 136/2026 and now he is on bail in that case. For the same occurrence, there are two cases have been lodged i.e. Buniyadganj P.S. Case No. 136/2026 and present case. After completion of investigation against the petitioner, charge-sheet has been submitted. Lastly he submitted that petitioner having one criminal antecedent vide Buniyadganj P.S. Case No. 136/2026 in which he is on bail and he is in judicial custody in this case since 05.05.2026. Hence, it is prayed for grant of regular bail to the accused petitioner.

4. Per contra the Ld. A.P.P. appeared on behalf of State opposed the prayer for bail.

5. Prosecution case, in brief, as per informant is that on 07.04.2026 he took the motorcycle of Bhola Rajvanshi and came to Civil Court, Gaya and at about 8.00 A.M. he parked the motorcycle at Masjid Road, near Masjid. When he came out from the Civil Court at

about 12.00 P.M. and found that his motorcycle was not parked there and his motorcycle was stolen by someone.

6. Heard both the parties and perused the material available on record. From perusal, it appears that petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. but during investigation his name has surfaced in this case. From perusal of para 43 of case diary, it transpires that the theft motorcycle bearing registration No. BR02BK-0537 has been recovered from the possession of co-accused Monu Kumar and on asking about the paper, he did not produced any paper and disclosed that he purchased the said motorcycle from the accused petitioner worth Rs. 11,000/-. Thereafter a raid was conducted at the house of accused petitioner Anand Kumar who was caught on the spot, who disclosed that the said motorcycle was purchased from co-accused Raja Kumar. From perusal of case record, it also transpires that for the same occurrence, two cases have been lodged one is Buniyadganj P.S. Case No. 136/2026 and second is present one and petitioner is already on bail in Buniyadganj P.S. Case No. 136/2026. Charge-sheet has been submitted after completion of investigation against accused petitioner and he is in judicial custody since 05.05.2026.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody and completion of investigation against him, I think, it is fit to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, subject to the condition that:-

- (i) One of the bailors shall be a close relative of the petitioner.
- (ii) He will not involve in any case in future except this case, otherwise, the prosecution would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of his bail bonds.
- (iii) He will remain present physically on each and every date till framing of charge.
