1. The bail petition has been filed and moved on behalf of incarcerated above named accused who is in judicial custody since 22.06.2026, arising out of Magadh University P.S. Case No.43 of 2025 for committing offence u/s 309(4) of B.N.S. pending in the Court of Ld. A.C.J.M.- VIII, Gaya.

2. Heard Learned Advocate for the petitioner and Learned A.P.P. for the State.

3. This case has been instituted on the information of informant Avinash Kumar Mishra who is alleging that on dated 16.02.2025 at about 04:49 A.M his company Budha Toyota is located in Matihani, in which some unknown criminals took the company's security guards and employees hostage, and broke the cash cabin door and ran away with the godrej inside in which there was about Rs.1,33,020/-. Thereafter, security guard informed about the incident to the Company Caretaker Ratna Ravidas and next to the Companies Officers. Hence this case.

4. The Learned defence counsel humbly submitted that the petitioner has filed before the Learned Court below which has been rejected by the Ld. A.C.J.M.-VIII Gaya on dated 06.07.2026 except this no anticipatory or regular bail petition filed before this Court or any Hon'ble higher Court. Further he submitted that the petitioner is quite innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case and he has committed not any offence. He further submitted that the petitioner was caught at the spot and nothing has been recovered from his possession. Lastly, he submitted that the petitioner has two criminal antecedents and he is in judicial custody since 22.06.2026, so the petitioner deserves the privilege of bail.

5. The Learned A.P.P. opposed the prayer and prayed to dismiss the petition of bail filed by the petitioner.

6. Heard the Learned Counsels for both the sides and perused the case record along with the LCR. From perusal of case record, it transpires that this case has been registered for the offence u/s 309(4) of B.N.S. against unknown accused persons and during investigation his name has been cropped in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused Subai Paswan which is at Para 93 of Case Diary and Para 57 of

Case Diary the statement of accused. From perusal of re-statement of informant at para 3 as well as witnesses at para 8 and 9 of the CD it appears that, they have supported the prosecution case. From perusal of seizure list, it appears that one red and black colour Pendrive of Sandisk company has been recovered from the possession of co-accused Avinash Kumar. From perusal of para 3 of the bail petition, it appears that petitioner has two criminal antecedent i.e. Pura P.S.- Case No- 65 of 2024 and Mahkar P.S. Case No- 91 of 2025.

7. Hence, considering the above facts and circumstances and gravity of nature of offence and criminal antecedent of petitioner, the prayer for regular bail of above named accused / petitioner is hereby **Rejected**.
