ORDER

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1. The present anticipatory bail petition has been filed and pressed today for order on behalf of above named petitioner who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Konch P.S. Case No.187 of 2026 for committing offence u/s 96 of BNS, pending in the court of Learned A.C.J.M.-VI, Gaya.

2. Heard Learned Advocate for the petitioner and Learned A.P.P. for the State.

3. This present case has been instituted by the written information given by the informant namely Sanju Devi and she alleged that on 15.06.2026 at about 09:00 A.M., her daughter/ victim XXX aged about 15 years went to Guraru Bajar for bringing household articles but she did not returned home till evening, she searched very much but could not traced her. On 18.06.2026 she got information that present petitioner lured her daughter and taken away her. From other person she call him and he accepted that he had taken away her daughter. Hence this case.

4. The Learned defence counsel humbly submitted that the petitioner has not filed any bail either anticipatory or regular bail petition before this Court or any Hon'ble higher Court. Further he submitted that petitioner is quite innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case due to other reason. He further stated that the case has been got compromised between the parties and now there is no any dispute between the parties. Lastly, he submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent, so the petitioner may be given the privilege of anticipatory bail.

5. The Learned A.P.P. opposed the prayer and prayed to dismiss the petition of bail filed by the petitioner.

6. Heard Learned Counsels for both the sides and perused the case record along with case diary. From perusal of case record, it transpires that, present case has been registered for the offence u/s 96 of BNS, against the present petitioner. From perusal of statement of victim recorded u/s 183 BNSS, it transpires that there is specific allegation of sexual assault upon the petitioner, who kidnapped the victim who is minor aged about 15 years along with other unknown person. Petitioner too victim

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forcibly to Delhi and confined her at unknown place and committed rape upon her continuously for four days. Ld. counsel for defence submitted that they have compromised their dispute and there is no dispute between the parties. Here, considering the age of victim and severity of allegation against the petitioner Court cannot be swayed by the submission which is ex-facie not-tenable. Further, investigation in the present case is still pending. From perusal of Para No.3 of bail petition, as well as Para No.33 of case diary, it transpires that present petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

7. Considering the discussion made above and the nature of allegation against accused / petitioner I am not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the accused / petitioner. Hence, prayer for anticipatory bail of above named accused / petitioner is hereby **Rejected**.
