ORDER

File is taken up today on the date already fixed.

Ld. Counsel for petitioner has submitted that both parties have compromised this case outside the Court and compromise petition also filed. Hence prayed to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the accused petitioners.

Per contra Ld. A.P.P. on behalf of stated has submitted that he has received case diary today but injury report is not available in the case diary. As per F.I.R. informant and his mother received injuries. Therefore injury report is necessary for disposal of the case. Hence prayed for some time to produce the injury report.

Informant present in the Court and admitted the factom of compromise.

Heard both sides and considering the submission of both parties as well as statement of informant, this Court thinks appropriate to issue No-coercive step to the **petitioners namely 1. Chhotu Manjhi, 2. Sumit Kumar and 3. Binod Manjhi till submission of injury report.**

Thus No-coercive action is directed against the above named petitioners till submission of injury report. In the meantime Ld. A.P.P. is directed to produce the injury report on the next.

Put up on 07.02.2026 for hearing.
