	Anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Kunti Devi, who is apprehending their arrest in connection with Uchkagaon P.S. Case No. 447/25, U/s 80/3(5) of the BNS. The prosecution story in brief is that above named petitioner along with other co-accused have killed the informant's sister-in-law for the demand of dowry. Hence, the present FIR. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner argued that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Learned counsel further argued that the prosecution story is totally false, fabricated and concocted. Learned counsel further argued that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. With these arguments learned counsel for the petitioner prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Ld. P.P. for the State opposed the bail prayer of the petitioner. Heard both the parties and perused the case diary. There are seven accused in this case but the petitioner is not named in the FIR. The petitioner is sister-in-law of the deceased. The allegation against the petitioner is that she was in illicit relationship with the husband of the deceased due to this reason she along with other named accused in the FIR has killed the deceased namely Lalsa Devi. Informant in her restatement in paragraph no. 18 of the case diary and all the witnesses in paragraph no. 19 & 20 has supported the case of the prosecution. On perusing the Postmortem Report, external examination of the deceased shows ligature mark-1 inch	

<u>Contd.</u> <u>24.03.2026</u>	broad, brownish in colour was present over upper part of neck above thyroid which runs from front of neck obliquely, extending upwards and backward up to left and right mastoid bone and deficient over back side of neck, hyoid bone is fractured. Cause of death of the deceased was due to asphyxia due to hanging. Charge-sheet has been submitted against other co-accused keeping investigation pending against these accused/petitioner. It means the petitioner has not cooperated in the investigation. So, at this stage the bail of the petitioner cannot be considered. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances, it is not a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly anticipatory bail of the petitioner stand rejected.
