	<p style="text-align: center;">Anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners namely Indra Devi & Sharik Ansari, who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Bhore P.S. Case No. 598/2025, U/s 112(2), 317(2), 325, 352 BNS & 11 Prevention of Animal Currelty Act and 4(2) Bihar Preservation and Improvement of Animal Act.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">The above case was registered on the written application of informant namely Om Jaiswal. The prosecution story in brief is that the accused were smuggling cows in a 14 wheeler truck registration no. BR21GC 1375. Hence, the FIR.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner argued that the petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. Learned counsel further argued that the prosecution story is totally false, fabricated and concocted. Learned counsel further argued that except the present case, no other case is pending against these petitioners and the petitioners bear clean past. With these arguments learned counsel for the petitioners prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Per contra, learned P.P. for the State argued that the offence alleged to have been committed by the petitioners are serious in nature, as such the petitioners are not entitled to grant anticipatory bail.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Having heard both the parties, I have gone through the case diary. The present bail has been filed on behalf of the petitioners in connection with a case registered under the provisions of the Prevention of Cruelty of Animals Act. The allegation against the petitioners are that certain animals were being transported in a truck. Petitioner no. 1 Indra</p>

Devi is owner of the truck whose document has been submitted before the court and petitioner no. 2 is Sharik Ansari is the driver of the alleged truck. All the cattle has been released by the petitioners to their owners as per submission of ld. counsel. The prosecution has not submitted any document regarding cruelty which has been caused by the petitioners.

Considering the nature of allegation of the case and the materials available on the record, anticipatory bail of the petitioners are hereby **allowed**. Let the petitioners in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks of the instant order before the Court below be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court below with conditions **that (i) the petitioners shall cooperate in the Trial Court proceedings (ii) The truck owner of the truck shall submit original document of the truck before the Ld. Trial Court & (iii) The petitioners shall file an affidavit that released animal will be produced before the Ld. Court whenever required for the Trial Court proceedings.**
