This Cri. Misc. Case is put up for hearing.

Heard both sides.

This criminal misc. case has been filed on behalf of above named petitioner with prayer to reduce the conditions given in order dated 15-12-2025 passed in B.P. No. 1039/2025, so that the petitioner may be able to furnish his bail bonds before the Id. court-below in the light of the said order.

It is *inter alia* submitted on behalf of petitioner that the prayer for bail of the petitioner was allowed with condition that ***Id. Court below is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and if it would be found that he has concealed his criminal history, his bail bonds shall not be accepted with further condition that one of the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner and one shall be local and he shall cooperate in the investigation or trial and he shall not temper with the evidence.***” by this court vide order dated 15-12-2025 passed in B.P. No. 1039/2025. It is further submitted that as a matter of fact, after granting his bail, petitioner could not be released from the custody because nobody in his family to take care of him and he himself will furnish his bail bonds and he is in custody since 11-04-2025. Hence, for the ends of justice, petitioner has prayed to reduce the condition and allowed him to furnish P.R. Bond.

On the other hand, ld. P.P. has not opposed the prayer of the petitioner.

From perusal of order dated 15-12-2025 passed in B.P. No. 1039/2025, it transpires that prayer for bail of the petitioner was allowed on 15-12-2025 with condition that ***“ld. Court below is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and if it would be found that he has concealed his criminal history, his bail bonds shall not be accepted with further condition that one of the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner and one shall be local and he shall cooperate in the investigation or trial and he shall not temper with the evidence.”*** due to aforesaid reasons petitioner could not furnish his bail bonds.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, taking lenient view, this Cri. Misc. case is allowed and condition of *one bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner and one shall be local* is relaxed and permitted him to furnish P.R. Bond before the ld. Court below with condition that he shall furnished bail bonds after one month of his releasing and other conditions shall remain unchanged.
