**Anticipatory Bail Application 385/2026**

**Jadopur P.S. Case No.-199/2025**

**Ramasaray Ram & 2 others Vs. State of Bihar**

**07-05-2026**

Anticipatory bail petition of accused persons namely Ramasaray ram, Rabadi Devi and Sandeep Kumar apprehending their arrest in connection with Jadopur P.S. Case No.-199/2025, registered U/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 118(2), 76, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of B.N.S., is put up for hearing.

In brief, the case of prosecution as per F.I.R., is that the informant of this case is *Pitambar Ram*. He stated that on dated 21.04.2025 at about 06:00 P.M., due to previous enmity his neighbor Rabdi Devi, Ramasaray Ram, Sandeep Kumar arms with Lathi-Danda and iron rod, came at the door of the informant, started abusing. When informant opposed it, all the accused began to assault him by lathi-danda and iron rod. Meanwhile, Rabdi Devi with the intention to kill strucked blow with Iron rod on my head. Due to this he sustained injury on the head. The victim fall on the ground. On cry the wife of the informant namely, Fulmati Devi, son Rahul Kumar came to save him then the accused also assaulted them by lathi-danda and iron-rod. After that the accused Ramasaray Ram threshed the informant's wife on the ground by catching her hair and dragged also and made her semi nude. Meanwhile, the accused Rabadi Devi snatched a golden Mangalshutra worth Rs. 30,000/- of the informant's wife. Nearby people arrived at the place of occurrence and took all the injured to Sadar Hospital Gopalganj for treatment. Hence this case is u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 118(2), 76, 303(2), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of B.N.S.

As per Para-2 of the petition, one anticipatory bail bearing no. 2708/2025 was dismissed in Non-Prosecution. There is no criminal history of the petitioners as per petition and they are ready to furnish the bail bond as per direction of the court.

Case-diary is called for. Perused the record. Ld. APP objected the bail application. On perusal of the case-diary and charge-sheet, it transpires that the accused petitioners were given benefits of section 35 of BNSS. Cognizance is already taken by the Ld. Trial Court u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 76, 382, 351(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. On very next date before issuance of summon the accused persons have filed this application for anticipatory Bail. The accused

persons have not misused the benefits given to them by I.O. u/s 35 of BNSS. Therefore, they are hereby directed to surrender before the Ld. Trial court within 6 weeks and ld. Trial Court could see no misuse of 35 BNSS by the petitioner and shall pass order according to law. Since, there is no apprehension of arrest by now, therefore, anticipatory bail of **Ramasaray Ram, Rabadi Devi and Sandeep Kumar** is *rejected*.
