Anticipatory Bail Application 558/2026

Sri Ram Mishra Vs. State of Bihar

17.04.2026 This bail application is filed on behalf of accused **Sri Ram Mishra**. His Ld. Counsel is present on calling. Ld. APP is also present. Heard both sides.

As per the anticipatory bail application, the accused petitioners have submitted that they have not filed any regular or anticipatory bail in this court or in Hon'ble High Court, Patna. In Para-3 they stated that they have **no** criminal antecedent. The petitioner is falsely implicated and he is ready to furnish bail bond and ready to comply the conditions imposed by the court.

The case of prosecution in short is that the informant of this case *Saroj Devi*. As per F.I.R., she stated that on dated 24.09.2022 at about 07:00 P.M. the husband of the informant while returning from Deoria by his own motorcycle when reached on the road in front of the house of Yoga then the accused petitioner Tuntun Mishra was crossing the road. Meanwhile, the motorcycle of the husband of the informant touched the leg of the Tuntun Mishra. Due to that Tuntun Mishra along with the husband of the informant fell down on the road. When the family of Tuntun Mishra got the information of this incidence then the accused persons namely Pankaj Mishra, Hemant Mishra, Yoga Mishra, Ajit Mishra, Keshav Mishra, Sri Ram Mishra, Golu Mishra and four to five other unknown persons all came with Lathi-Danda and iron-rod to the informant and began to abuse and also began to assault to the informant and her husband. Due to this attack the husband of the informant fell down at the place of occurrence. Even then the accused persons began to assault the husband of the informant in lying position. The informant also stated that the accused persons namely

Pankaj Mishra and Hemant Mishra beat the husband of the informant by kick on the chest of the husband of the informant. Due to this it began bleeding from the mouth of the husband of the informant. After that the local police was informed. The injured (Husband of the informant) was sent to Vijaipur Hospital. From there he was referred to Gorakhpur Hospital for treatment. Hence, this case was registered u/s 341, 323, 325, 307, 504/34 of I.P.C.

Case diary is called for. There is no specific allegation against the accused petitioner. There is no allegation of commission of specific injury on the accused petitioner. He has no criminal antecedent.

Hence, Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and materials available on the record Court is inclined to enlarge the above named petitioner ***on anticipatory Bail.***

Therefore, the accused petitioner **Sri Ram Mishra** is ordered to be released on furnishing Bail bond and surety of **10,000X2**. The petitioner must surrender and file the bail bond within 28 days of this order. The petitioners must present on each and every date till framing of charge.
