	<p>Bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner Abhishek Ranjan @ Abhishek, who is in judicial custody since 13.02.2026 in connection with Gopalganj, P.S. Case No. 869/2025, registered U/s. 316(2), 318(4), 338, 336(2), 340(2), 351(2)/3(5) BNS.</p> <p>As per allegation, the complainant has given Rs. 50 lac to the co-accused Vivek Ranjan and others with promise of the co-accused that they will pay back the money to the informant in crores, but on demand they did not pay a single paisa. Hence, the present FIR.</p> <p>Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner argued that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Learned counsel further argued that the prosecution story is totally false, fabricated and concocted. Learned counsel further argued that the petitioner has criminal antecedent of four cases. With these arguments the learned counsel for the petitioner prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.</p> <p>Per contra, learned. P.P. for the State argued that the offence alleged to have been committed by the petitioner is serious in nature, as such the petitioner is not entitled to grant anticipatory bail.</p> <p>Heard both the parties and perused the case record. Hon'ble High Court has granted bail of this petitioner vide Criminal Miscellaneous No. 4447 of 2026 dated 04.02.2026 with two observation (i) In case, it is brought to the notice of the Court below that the petitioners have any criminal antecedents, Ld. Court below shall cancel the bail bonds of the petitioners after hearing them and getting satisfied that the petitioners have concealed their criminal antecedents despite their knowledge of the same. (ii) The informant will have liberty to take steps to get the bail bonds cancelled, if it</p>	

<p>Contd. 13-03-2026</p>	<p>is found that they have also got the money out of Rs. 50 lacks as given by the informant to the accused persons. The petitioner has concealed the criminal antecedent before the Court so, Ld. Court of C.J.M. Gopalganj has cancelled the bail of this petitioner vide Order dated 13.02.2026. Further, on 28.02.2026 the petitioner has applied for bail before the court concerned then the bail of this petitioner has been rejected.</p> <p>Considering the entire statement, the petitioner has been granted bail by the Hon'ble High Court but he has concealed the criminal antecedent before the Hon'ble Court. The allegation against the accused are that there was one scheme in which one will get profit of crores in three months in exchange of depositing money in the financial scheme. The main accused is Vivek Ranjan @ Sonu Mishra who is father of the petitioner and Naushal Ali where money has been deposited in the their bank account. The defendant has filed all the money transaction receipt. Ld. Counsel for the informant was also present at the time of hearing of the bail application. There is no prima facie evidence against the petitioner.</p> <p>Therefore, after taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of this case, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of equal amount to the satisfaction of Ld. Court concerned with condition that (i) the petitioner shall cooperate in the Trial Court proceedings (ii) Since, the petitioner has criminal antecedent of four cases so, he shall file an affidavit that in case of repetition of any type of offence with which he has been charged with in future his bail bond shall be automatically cancelled, (iii) the petitioner shall comply all the conditions passed by the Hon'ble High Court in Cri. Misc. No. 4447 of 2026 dated 04.02.2026 (iv) the petitioner shall file an affidavit stating the specific nature of each cases registered against him & (v) The informant shall be at liberty to pray for cancellation of the bail of the petitioner if the petitioner try to tamper with the evidence or not complying all the conditions of his bail bond.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Dictated)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Kailash Joshi) A.S.J.-I</p>
