1. This bail application filed on behalf of above named accused-petitioner, who is in judicial custody since 18-12-2025, in connection with Manjagarh P.S. Case No. 450 of 2025, registred U/S 126(2), 351(2), 352, 118(1) and 109/3(5) of the B.N.S., is put up for hearing today.

2. As per the FIR, prosecution case in brief is that on the basis of written application of the informant, Manjagarh P.S. Case No. 450 of 2025 has been lodged against the petitioner and other for the alleged offence of dated 12-12-2025. It is inter alia alleged in the F.I.R. that informant's younger brother namely Sabir Ali is vehicle in-charge in British International Arabi school, Domahata, Manjagarh and in this school, Khalid Hussain works as schook Maintenance In-charge. On dated 12-12-2025 at about 09:00 am, son of accused Khalid Hussain namely Imdadul Hussain (petitioner) asked a vehicle for wandering from the informant's younger brother and informant's brother refused to give vehicle, due to which altercation took place between the parties and petitioner threatened to kill him. On dated 16-12-2025, at about 11:00 O'clock, informant's brother was going to school from Dhamapakad and as soon as, he arrived near Government school Domahata, petitioner and one unknown accused surrounded him and while abusing ordered to kill him and petitioner inflicted knife blow below his chest and he sustained bleeding injury and he fell down and after that he was inflicted knife blow repeatedly in his abdomen, back, hand and head and thinking him dead, they fled away from there. Thereafter, school staff and villagers brought the injured at Sadar Hospital, Gopalganj, from where, he was referred to Gorakhpur, where he was undergone treatment.

3. It is submitted on behalf of the accused-petitioner that he is innocent and has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that nothing has happened as has been

alleged by the informant of this case. It is further submitted that petitioner has absolutely clean antecedent and has never been involved in any criminal case. It is lastly submitted that petitioner has got clean antecedent and he is in custody since 18-12-2026. On such strength, prayer for bail has been made by the petitioner.

4. Heard ld. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as ld. P.P. for the State. Ld. P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner. During the course of hearing of this bail matter, ld. Counsel for the informant appeared and vehemently opposed the bail prayer of the petitioner.

5. Having heard both the parties and perused the case record along with case diary. From the perusal of the F.I.R as well as case diary, it transpires that petitioner is named in the F.I.R. against whom there is allegation that he has allegedly inflicted knife blow below the chest of the informant's brother namely Sabir Ali and he sustained bleeding injury and he fell down and he again inflicted knife blow repeatedly in his abdomen, back, hand and head. Informant and witnesses at para-02, 05 and 06 of the case diary have fully supported the case of the prosecution. Para-33 of the case diary shows that petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. From perusal of the injury report of injured Sabir Ali at para-36 of the case diary, it appears that four incised wounds have been found on the chest, flank, shoulder and occipital temporal region of the injured opined to be grievous in nature caused by sharp cutting substance. From perusal of para-48 of the case diary, it appears that during the course of investigation, allegation against the petitioner has been found to be true and Charge-Sheet No. 46/26 dated 16-02-2026 has been submitted.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of this case and considering the seriousness of the offence, this court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, bail prayer of the petitioner is hereby **rejected with observation that petitioner may renew his bail prayer after framing of charge.**
