The Ld. counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It was further submitted by the Ld. Counsel that the name of this petitioner came on the confessional statement of co-accused Nausad Alam. It was further submitted by the Id. Counsel that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and nothing incriminating article has been recovered from his possession. It was further submitted by the petitioner is that the prosecution story is totally false, fabricated and concocted. Hence, he deserves bail.</p> <p>6. On the other hand, the Ld. Addl.
