	<b><u>30.03.2026</u></b>	<p><b>1.</b> This application for anticipatory bail is filed on behalf of the above named petitioner who apprehends his arrest in connection with Kuchaikote P.S. Case No. 319/2024 for the offence punishable u/s 126(2), 115(2), 110, 3(5) BNS.</p> <p><b>2.</b> Petitioner has given certificate in para 2 of the bail application that earlier no application for anticipatory or regular bail has been filed before any of the Court or any Court superior to this Court. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has mentioned in para-3 of the petition that Petitioner has clean past.</p> <p><b>3.</b> Heard, the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned A.P.P. for the State.</p> <p><b>4.</b> As per the factual matrix of the case, the prosecution case in brief is that on 19.07.2024 informant's son viz. Sonu Kumar returned from his garden and as soon as he reached near Hirdayanand Chauhan's House, all the accused persons made under conspiracy and surrounded him with an intention of killing after which informant's son called informant's husband from which the informant came to know and as soon as informant reached there she saw that Priya Kumari, Sanjana Kumari and Suganti Devi were pulling the dupatta wrapped around the neck of the informant's husband and at the same time, Anita Devi hit the informant's husband on his head due to which he sustained head injury and he became unconscious after which the informant took him to the hospital for treatment where the doctor declared him dead.</p> <p><b>5.</b> The Ld. counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. It was further submitted by the petitioner is that the prosecution story is totally false, fabricated and concocted. Hence, he deserves anticipatory bail.</p>	<b>Contd.....)</b>

<p><b>30.03.2026</b> <b>(.....Contd)</b></p>	<p>6. On the other hand, the Ld. Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.</p> <p>7. Heard both the sides and perused the entire case record. From perusal of the same, it is found that the present case was instituted vide Kuchaikote P.S. Case. No. 319/2024 under Section u/s 126(2), 115(2), 110, 3(5) BNS out of which the offences under Section 110 BNS is non-bailable. There is an specific allegation of assault over this petitioner and from perusal of the record, it was found that the death of victim caused due to assault by the petitioner and other co-accused. This case is still under investigation.</p> <p>8. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and serious nature of offence, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the anticipatory bail application of the petitioner is here by <b>rejected</b>.</p> <p>The above named petitioner is directed to surrender before the Ld. Court below within four weeks and seek regular bail. Ld. Court below is hereby directed to pass an order of bail as an when applied by this petitioner without being prejudiced by this order.
