	<p>Bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner Kumari Ranju Yadav, in connection with Hathua, P.S. Case No. 353/2025, registered U/s 126(2), 115(2), 118, 109, 303(2), 352, 351(3)/3(5) BNS, who is in custody since 18-02-2026.</p> <p>As per F.I.R., prosecution story in brief is that on 09.12.2025, the informant was assaulted by her daughter-in-law and other co-accused persons with bricks on the informant's head due to which she got injured and referred to Gopalganj for treatment. Hence, the present F.I.R.</p> <p>Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner argued that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Learned counsel further argued that the prosecution story is totally false, fabricated and concocted. Learned counsel further argued that the <b>petitioner has clean past</b>. With these arguments the learned counsel for the petitioners prayed for grant of bail to the petitioners.</p> <p>Per contra, Ld. P.P. for the State opposed the bail prayer of the petitioners.</p> <p>Heard the Ld. Counsels for the parties and perused the case diary. The allegation against the petitioner is that she wants the informant's pension and her land due to which her daughter-in-law has assaulted the informant by bricks on the head with the help of other co-accused. The injured is the mother-in-law of the petitioner. On perusal of the injury of the injured shows lacerated wound on back side of head size 1.5 x 0.5 cm and swelling on back side of head size 5cm x 4cm and also NCCT of head is reserved. The offence alleged is serious in nature. Injury is on the vital part of the body.</p>	

<p><b><u>Contd.</u></b> <b><u>16.04.2026</u></b></p>	<p>There is an intention to kill by the petitioner. The petitioner is a lady but she has assaulted on the back part of the head which is very sensitive part of the head. There is also matrimonial dispute pending between the parties. The anticipatory bail of other co-accused has been disposed off with the condition to surrender and seek for regular bail vide A.B.P. No. 590/26 today i.e. 16.04.2026.</p> <p>Keeping in view the seriousness of the offence, I am not inclined to grant the petitioner on regular bail. Accordingly regular bail petition of the petitioner is hereby <b>rejected</b>.
