	Anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners 1.) Ramesh Singh@ Ramesh Kumar Singh who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Vijayipur, P.S. Case No. 210/2025, registered U/s 126(2), 115, 132, 352, 351(2), 303(2), 3(5) of B.N.S. The prosecution story based on written application of Shambhu Prasad presently working as Revenue Officer is that when the informant was on field trip and coming to Panchayat govt. building Bandhora, at that time, the informant was waylaid by Ramesh Singh and thereafter, the informant was subjected to physical and verbal abuse. It is alleged that the accused snatched 1500 rupees from the pocket of the informant. Hence, the FIR. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner argued that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Learned counsel further argued that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. With these arguments learned counsel for the petitioner prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Ld. P.P. for the State opposed the bail prayer of the petitioners. Having heard the Id. Counsel for the parties and perused the case diary. The allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner has subjected the informant to verbal and physical abuse. As mentioned in injury report, no external injury was seen on the informant. It is noted that no specific reason or motive behind the occurrence has been disclosed in the case diary. It is further noted that no specific overt act or incident has been attributed to the petitioner showing as to how he hindered or obstructed the official work of the public servants concerned. Therefore, it is a fit case to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. The anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner is allowed. Let the petitioner in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks of the instant order before the Court below be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of equal amount with the conditions that (i) the petitioner will cooperate fully with the Investigating Officer (ii) the petitioner shall not leave the court's jurisdiction till the completion of the investigation.
