1. The present anticipatory bail petition is preferred by above named petitioner, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with **Kuchaikote P.S. Case No. 161 of 2026, for the offences U/s.- 329(3), 308(4), 308(5), 109(1), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S. and 27 Arms Act. Subsequently, on 18.4.2026 U/s. 111(3), 111(4) & 61(2) B.N.S.** was added in the F.I.R. is put up for hearing/order.
2. Heard, Sri Seikh Asgar learned counsel, on behalf of the petitioner as well as Id. P.P., Gopalganj for the State along with Id. Counsel Sri Raj Kamal and Sri Rakesh Rai for the informant.
3. During the course of hearing Id. counsel for the petitioner has filed a petition and submitted that during the pendency of the present Anticipatory Bail Petition, the petitioner approached the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India by filing a Writ Petition No. 215/2026 titled as **Amrendra Kumar Pandey @ Pappu Pandey & Anr. Vs. State of Bihar & Ors.** On 27.05.2026, the aforesaid writ petition was disposed with certain observations by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India “ no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioners pursuant to FIR No.5139008260161 of 2026 till the matter is taken up for effective hearing by the High Court. Meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to move an appropriate application before the High Court for early disposal of their pending petition.” Further, it is submitted that in view of the aforesaid order dated 27.05.2026 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme
