ORDER:

Arguments heard on the objections filed by the objectors/JDs no.1&4, wherein it is pleaded that arbitrator has wrongly enhanced the compensation to the land owners and the objectors have already challenged the award dated 30.3.2019 and filed application under Section 36 (2) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act. Excessive principle amount and interest have been claimed by the decree holder. So prayer is made for acceptance of the objections and for dismissal of the execution.

2. In reply, all the averments of the application are denied and prayer is made for dismissal of the same.

3. Heard. Record perused. At the time of arguments, both learned counsel for the parties have admitted that objections under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act filed by Union of India as well as the land owners have been dismissed and the award has become final. So keeping in view of the said circumstances, SDM Rajpura is directed to calculate the amount due to the decree holder as per award of the arbitrator and make the payment to the decree holder directly under intimation to this Court and submit the report on 14.3.2022, failing which he is directed to appear in person. Copy of this order be sent to Project Director NHAI for compliance also. If no compliance is made then Project Direction National Highway Authority of India is also directed to appear in person.
