1. Anticipatory Bail Application filed on behalf of above named petitioners who apprehend their arrest in connection with Manjhagarh P.S. Case No. 115/26, U/s. 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 109(1), 324(4), 351(2), 352, 3(5) of B.N.S and 27 Arms Act is put up for hearing today.
2. Heard both sides.
3. Ld. counsel for the petitioners filed a petition and submitted that in the present applicants Sukath Sah and Sonu Kumar are the petitioners in the aforesaid anticipatory bail application. That accused/petitioners Sukath Sah and Sonu Kumar have been arrested by the police in connection with the same case on 26.05.2026 and is presently in judicial custody. That in view of the arrest of the applicants, the prayer for anticipatory bail has become infructuous and no longer maintainable qua the applicants Sukath Sah and Sonu Kumar. That the petitioners does not want to press this anticipatory bail so far. That Ld. APP on behalf of state has no objection to the deletion/withdrawal of the name of the applicants Sukath Sah and Sonu Kumar from the present anticipatory bail application and the same may be allowed to proceed only in respect of the remaining petitioners.
