	Bail petition dated 09.09.2025 has been filed on behalf of the accused-petitioner Vikky Kumar @ Aarabh Srivastava stated therein that the petitioner is innocent and he has committed no offence rather he has been falsely been implicated in this case. It has also been stated that earlier regular bail application was rejected by Hon'ble High Court Patna vide Cri. Misc. No. 12122/25 with the observation that speedy trial is a constitutional vision of justice. For this reason, the Superintendent of Police, Gopalganj, is directed to take necessary action by instructing the concerned SHO/IO to ensure the production of the remaining one witness in connection with Barauli P.S. Case No. 249 of 2021 at the earliest, so that the trial be concluded within two months from the date of production of the order. On the other hand the Ld. Additional Public Prosecutor has opposed the prayer of bail to the petitioner. Heard both sides and perused the case record. Since, according to the Ld. Public Prosecutor the Hon'ble High Court, Patna has also rejected the bail petition of this petitioner in Cri. Misc. No. 12122/25 and Circle Officer has seized items from the Malkhana and to be exhibited. Petitioner having criminal antecedent of 10 cases which shows that the petitioner is of habitual offender. Considering the above facts in light of Section 37 of N.D.P.S. Act, one kg Charas has been recovered from the possession of this petitioner. Therefore, I am not inclined to grant the petitioner on bail. Therefore, the petition dated 09.09.2025 is hereby rejected and disposed off. (Dictated) (Kailash Joshi) A.S.J.-I
