August Yadav Vs. State of Bihar

29.07.2026 This bail application is filed on behalf of petitioner namely, **August Yadav**. Ld. Counsel is present before the court on calling. Ld. PP is also present before the court. Heard both sides.

As per Bail petition it is submitted that there are **five** criminal antecedents against the accused petitioner except this. The petitioner is ready to furnish bail bond to the satisfaction of the Court. He is in judicial custody w.e.f. 07.05.2026.

Ld. PP has opposed the Bail.

The case of prosecution in short is that the informant of this case is *Shailesh Kumar Khatik*. As per F.I.R., he stated that on dated 18.02.2026 at about 7 P.M. he was going to Deoria with his Apachi motorcycle. When he reached at Khajuraha mod, meanwhile the accused person along with other co-accused namely, Abhishek Yadav, Manoj Yadav, Abhishek Chauhaan all came with motorcycle and encircled the informant. Abhishek Yadav attacked the informant with knife. Due to that he got cut injury on his hand. Meanwhile, the co-accused Manoj Yadav pointed a Katta on him. He became scared. The co-accused namely, Abhishek Chauhaan and Manoj looted Rs. 50,000/- from the informant what he kept for treatment of his nephew and the accused August Yadav snatched the Apachi motorcycle of the informant. After that accused along with all the co-accused fled away from the spot. The informant

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further alleged that this incidence was committed with pre planned manner. Hence, this case is registered u/s 126(2), 109, 303(2), 3(5) B.N.S.

Heard both parties and perused the record. The accused person is named in FIR. There are five criminal antecedents of the accused petitioner. He is in judicial custody w.e.f. **07.05.2026**. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner, there is omnibus allegation. Injury-report of Shailesh Kumar Khatik is also attached in this record. Injury is not on any vital part of the body. The injury is simple in nature.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, this court finds it fit to admit the petitioner/accused to the privilege of bail and accordingly, they are **permitted** to be enlarged **on bail** on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with **two sureties** of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Ld. court.
