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|                          | <p>Anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioners <b>1.) Bablu Patel</b> who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Bhore, P.S. Case No. 189/2020, registered U/s 387, 34 of the I.P.C.</p> <p>The Prosecution case, in brief, is that the informant Prabhu Sah launched prosecution, presenting written report, stating therein that On 13.07.2020, while the informant was at his residence, at about 10:07 p.m., he received a call on his mobile number 9939687407 from mobile number 6387774167. The caller disclosed his name as Vishal Singh and demanded a sum of Rs. 1,40,000/- from him. The caller directed the informant to pay the said amount by 9:00 a.m. on the following day and, in case of non-payment, threatened him with dire consequences. On 14.07.2020, at about 8:00 a.m., the informant again received a call from mobile number 7488253257. The caller inquired about the payment, whereupon the informant expressed his inability to pay the demanded amount. Thereafter, the caller reduced the demand to Rs. 70,000/- and directed the informant to pay the same by 9:00 a.m. on the next day. The caller further threatened that, in case of non-payment, he would shoot the informant and also cause harm to and terrorize his children. Hence, the FIR.</p> <p>Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner argued that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. Learned counsel further argued that <b>the petitioner has no criminal antecedent</b>. With these arguments learned counsel for the petitioner prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.</p> <p>Ld. P.P. for the State opposed the bail prayer of the petitioners.</p> <p>Having heard the ld. Counsel for the parties and perused the case diary. I have gone through the case record alongwith case diary. It appears that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. rather their names came on surface in the confessional statement of co-accused and except this, there is nothing against the petitioner in the</p> |                |

It also appears that the co-accused persons have been enjoying the privilege of bail vide <b>A.B.P. no. 775/2023 dated 12.05.2023 &amp; B.P. No. 894/2020 dated 06.01.2021</b> respectively and the bail of this petitioner falls on similar footing. As per submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner has no any criminal antecedent.</p> <p>Therefore, it is a fit case to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Let the petitioner in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks of the instant order before the Court below be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of equal amount.
