	<p>Anticipatory bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner namely Md. Sagir @ Md. Shageer @ Devid @ Pratik, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Kuchaikote P.S. Case No. 116/25, registered U/s 303(2), 318(2) &amp; 111(2) BNS.</p> <p>As per the prosecution case, the allegation against the petitioner is that he along with the other accused persons were trying to tamper with the A.T.M. Hence, the FIR.</p> <p>Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner argued that the petitioner is innocent and committed no offence. Learned counsel further argued that the petitioner is falsely implicated. <b>Learned counsel further argued that the petitioner has clean past.</b> With these arguments learned counsel for the petitioner prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.</p> <p>On the other hand the learned P.P. for the State that offence alleged to have committed by the petitioner is serious in nature and petitioner is not entitled to grant anticipatory bail.</p> <p>Having heard the Id. Counsel for the parties and perused the case record as well as case diary. It is evident that petitioner is named in the FIR who ran away while committing fraud of money by tampering with the ATM. The informant at paragraph no. 5 of the case diary has fully supported the case of the prosecution. In para no. 6 of the case diary, the other co-accused has confessed the name of this petitioner about the complicity in this case. All the witnesses have fully supported the case of the</p>

Kuchaikote through Email in which the petitioners along with other co-accused has been seen committing fraud on money by tempering with the A.T.M. This is an economic offence which has to be taken seriously. Main accused who was apprehended from the place of occurrence has been granted bail by the Hon'ble High Court in Cri. Misc. No. 38085 of 2025 dated 13.08.2025.</p> <p>On the basis of aforesaid facts and observations, the petitioner is directed to surrender and seek for regular bail.
