This anticipatory bail petition has been filed on behalf of petitioner **Chandradeo Yadav** who is apprehending arrest in Jhajha P.S. Case No. 115/2025 registered U/s- 191(2), 191(3), 190, 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 109, 352 of B.N.S. the copy of which is served upon the Id. P.P.

The Id. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that that no other bail petition was filed either in this Id. Court or before Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioner has got one criminal case vide GR. No. 184/2024 which is pending in the Court of Sri Animesh Ranjan, J.M Ist Class in which he is on bail. The police did not give notice u/s 35(3) of B.N.S.S to the petitioner. As per Id. Counsel the petitioner is innocent, has committed no offence and has falsely been implicated in this case. The co-accused persons have been granted bail by this Court. The petitioner is man of means and there is no chance of his absconding and he is ready to furnish bail bond to the satisfaction of Id. Court. In such view the Id. Counsel prayed to admit the petitioner to anticipatory bail.

The Id. Addl. PP opposed the prayer for bail.

On perusal of the case diary it is clear that the petitioner is not F.I.R. named. As per the fardbayan of Ajay Mandal 6 accused persons on 13.03.2024 at 10 A.M came to the house of the informant and Dina Yadav assaulted at the head of informant with iron rod causing injury. The accused Arvind Yadav, Siyaram Yadav, Vijay Yadav and Anandi Yadav having lathi in their hands assaulted Jagdeo Mandal, Prabhakar Mandal, Diwakar Kumar and Ganpat Mandal. It is also stated that two days before this incident Arvind Yadav, Chandeswar Yadav were committing theft of sand from the land of informant party by tractor and due to such objection the accused persons committed this act. The informant in his re-statement in CD para-3 has stated the same facts. The witnesses in CD para-7, 8, 40, 77, 78 and 79 have fully supported the incident. The allegation against the petitioner is that he is main conspirator of this incident and illegal sand theft as per fardbayan. As

per injury report CD para-20, 21, 22, 23 and supplementary report in CD para- 49, 50, 51, 52 all injuries are simple in nature. The Court finds that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner.

Accordingly in view of the facts and circumstances of this case having regard to the arguments of both the parties, this anticipatory bail petition is **allowed**. The petitioner Chandradeo Yadav in the event of his arrest or surrender is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the concerned Court and as per condition of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
