17-12-2020	Heard Ld. Counsel for the defence/petitioner Sri Dharendra Kumar Singh, Advocate and Ld. A.P.P. Sri Lakhan Bhagat, Advocate on behalf of the state, on bail petition filed on behalf of the accused Suresh Ram S/o Late Ganesh Ram Singh and perused the record. It is submitted that the petitioner was allowed bail vide B.P. No. 302/2008 and case was committed to the court of Session on 12-06-2008 and he was allowed on previous bail on 08-08-2008 and he remained regular till 19-07-2017, in the mean time some witnesses have been examined. On 28-07-2017 he was absent and no representation petition was filed by the then conducting Ld. Lawyer and his bail was cancelled of which the conducting Ld. Lawyer has got no information of cancellation of bail on 28-07-2017, so he used to file representation petition, which have been cancelled and thereafter the petitioner was declared absconder on 05-03-2020. Subsequently, he was arrested on 27-11-2020 and remanded to jail custody, since then he is in jail custody. Since framing of charge on 13-10-2008 out of twenty two witnesses and only six witnesses have been examined up to 18-02-2013, thereafter not a single witness has been examined. On perusal of record it shows that the petitioner was regular since 19-07-2017 and his bail bond was cancelled on 28-07-2017 due to non filing representation petition. Although on that date no any witness was present, thereafter the conducting Ld. Lawyer of the defence used to file representation petition till 05-12-2017 on six dates. Thereafter processes were issued and he was declared absconder on 29-05-2019 and permanent warrant was issued against all five accused persons. It is submitted that this was the first default of the petitioner and he will be regular in future and he assured of no such default in future and also assured the rest accused persons will also appear within a

In the facts and circumstances the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each with condition that he will physically present on each date fixed for one year or till disposal whichever earlier, and will be regular either physically or properly represented through Ld. Lawyer subsequently.
