1. The present anticipatory bail application has been filed on behalf of the accused petitioners namely **1. Dropati Devi @ Dropati Devi, W/o Girja Goswami, aged about 56 years, and 2. Barun Goswami @ Barun Kumar, S/o Girja Goswami, aged about 19 years, both are R/o Village- Jogidih, P.S.-Chandramandi, District- Jamui** who are apprehending their arrest in connection with Chandramandi P.S. Case No. 16/2026 registered under sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 109(1), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of the B.N.S.

2. The case of the prosecution in brief is that on dated 10.01.2026, when the informant Sangita Devi was warming herself by lightening fire at her house, at the same time accused persons namely Chandeshwar Goswami, Barun Goswami, Girja Goswami and Dropti Devi started abusing and misbehaving, hearing the noise when her husband and Deber came there, accused Chandeshwar Goswami assaulted her husband on his head with Farse due to which he sustained head injury, meanwhile, accused Girja Goswami assaulted her Deber on his head with Tangi due to which he sustained head injury. The accused petitioners would have killed her husband and Deber. On the basis of above, FIR was lodged against the accused persons.

3. Learned counsel for petitioners submits that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence and have falsely been implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. No other bail petition is pending against the petitioners either before this court or Hon'ble High Court, Patna. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent. All the alleged sections are bailable in nature except section 118(1) and 109(1) of the B.N.S. which are not made out against the petitioners since the petitioners are non-assailants. Hence, it has been prayed to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail.

4. On the other hand, learned Addl. P.P. has vehemently opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

5. Heard both the parties in detail and perused the record.

6. The FIR has been registered for the offence punishable under sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118(1), 109(1), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of the B.N.S. The re-statement of the informant has been recorded vide para no. 2 and statement of witnesses has been recorded vide para no. 3, 7, 8, and 30 of the case diary. The injury report of the injured is also attached with the case diary.

7. Perusal of the record reflects that though there is allegation against accused petitioners of abusing and misbehaving with the informant, however, there is no specific allegation of assault

against the instant accused petitioners. Moreover, injury report of injured Mohan Goswami reflects that there is no evidence of substantial injury to the injured. The injury of injured Rajo Goswami has been opined to be simple in nature. The allegation qua the petitioners appears to be general and omnibus in nature.

8. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, and nature of general and omnibus allegations levelled against this petitioners, the anticipatory bail application of accused petitioners namely **Dropati Devi @ Dropadi Devi and Barun Goswami @ Barun Kumar, is hereby allowed.** Accordingly, it is ordered that at the event of arrest or surrender of the above-named petitioners before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of this order shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below with the conditions as laid down U/s. 482(2) of B.N.S.S.
