This regular bail petition has been filed by petitioner **Chhotelal Marandi** who is in custody since 25.01.2026 in connection with Bichkorwa P.S. Case No. 79/2025 registered u/s- 126(2), 115, 117(1), 118(1), 109, 74, 352, 351(2), 351(3), 190 of B.N.S, the copy of which is served upon the Id. P.P.

The Id. Counsel for the custody accused has submitted that accused petitioner is rotting in jail since 25.01.2026. The regular bail petition was rejected on 30.01.2026 by Id. A.C.J.M-II, Jamui and after that no any other bail petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner in any other Court except the present one. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. That a case has also been registered by the applicant in connection with Bichkorwa P.S CAse No.-81/2025 in which several people including the informant have been made accused. It is clear from the case and counter case filed by both sides that there was land dispute between both sides. Both sides belong to the tribal community who are economically weak. All sections areailable except sections 109 of BNS which is super added to make the case non-ailable. As per Id. Counsel the petitioner is innocent, has committed no offence and has been falsely implicated in the case. On the other side in the counter case the accused Shymmlal Marandi has been granted bail by Id. District Judge, Jamui vide B.A No. 150/2026 dated 10.03.2026. The petitioner is a man of means and there is no chance of his absconding and he is ready to furnish bail bond to the satisfaction of Id. Court. In such view the Id. Counsel prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

The Id. Addl.P.P opposed the prayer for bail.

On perusal of LCR and case diary it is clear that on the basis of written information of Syamlal Marandi, the Bichkorwa P.S. Case No. 79/2025 was registered u/s- 126(2), 115, 117(1), 118(1), 109, 74, 352, 351(2), 351(3), 190 of B.N.S, wherein he has stated that on 13-15.11.2025 he was putting on the barn(aar) after cutting his paddy crop field. At about 10:00 in the morning twenty accused persons assembled 1. Sadho Lal Marandi, 2. Kishun Marandi, 3. Sono lal Marandi, 4. Rassi Marandi, 5. Chhote Lal Marandi, 6. Nathan Marandi and 7. Ranjeet Marandi all armed with tangi, farsa, lathi, tir-banjar suddenly came to his plot and tried to take away the paddy crop. Upon his objection, Sodho Marandi armed with farsa with

intention to kill assaulted at his head causing cut and it started bleeding. When his father Munshi Marandi came to save him, Chhotelal Marandi having tangi assaulted at left hand of his father causing cut and it started bleeding. Hoplal Marandi also came to save him but they assaulted him with tangi. They assaulted his wife and brother Kishun Marandi with lathi and injured them. Sonelal Marandi told that all the persons who were cutting his paddy crop will be killed and Rassi Marandi assaulted Anita Hansda and Rani Hansda. Chhotelal Marandi having tangi assaulted at the left hand of Sanju Marandi causing cut and it started bleeding. Nathan Marandi assaulted Biralal Marandi and injured him. The informant in his re-statement in CD para-2 has stated the same facts. The witnesses in CD paras- 5, 6, 11 and 12 have supported the case of prosecution. The injury report of Shyamlal Marandi(informant) as per CD para-75 is simple in nature. While the injuries of Biren @Biralal Marandi, Rani Hansda, Chhotu Marandi, Mauji Soren, Munshi Marandi are also simple in nature. The Court finds that there is no direct allegation against the petitioner. there is case and counter case between parties. The petitioner is in jail since 25.01.2026.

Therefore considering the facts and circumstances of this case having regard to the submissions advanced by both the parties, the custody accused **Chhotelal Marandi** is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the concerned court.
